We are a small family farm, respecting the land and appreciating the food it provides.

We believe a farm is a celebration of nature's gifts. Our goal is to harness those gifts through a combination of low acreage-high production farming methods, organic practices and extended season tools. To extend the growing season and maximize the natural systems provided throughout the year, we use three movable high tunnels, succession plantings and strong crop rotations.

We are Certified Naturally Grown which means we only use organic practices on our farm and we are inspected every year.

We believe healthy soil is the key to a sustainable and nutritionally dense food system so we focus our efforts on supporting bio-diversity, limiting tillage, and feeding our soil biology lots of compost.

We are also a Micro-Farm! We are farming just over a 1/2 acer but with our intensive growing practices and extended season we are able to grow as much produce as a traditional 3 acer market farm. In this way, we make the best use of resources and cut down on labor.

WHAT IS A CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a partnership between share members and a farmer in order to produce a high-quality product to share with a community of people who care about food and how it is produced. It is a great way for families to enjoy seasonal food from local farms, live a more sustainable life, and learn about the natural systems around them.

A CSA share is exactly what it means: a member shares in the bounty of harvest, community on the farm, and some of the risk a farmer takes in their dependence on weather and natural pest managements. By buying a share before the harvest season begins, a member is helping the farmer to buy seed and supplies. In return, the member receives a consistent supply of fresh, local produce throughout the season.

A 10TH ST. CSA

At 10th St. Farm & Market we offer 4 CSA options: a spring share, a summer share, a fall share and now a winter share! Because we specialize in extended season harvest we have cold weather crops able to be harvested from the high tunnels in the winter and a early start to heat loving crops in the warmer months. We also grow an array of micro-greens in our greenhouse all year. Through simple season extension tools, we are able to provide cold Minnesotans with something fresh to eat all year, even in the winter.

10TH ST. CSA BENIFETS:

-Certified Naturally Grown Produce! We only use organic practices on our farm and get inspected annually

-Extended season produce: greens all winter, early tomatoes and peppers and fresh Christmas produce utilizing our movable high tunnels and greenhouse.

-Know your farmer and how we grow your food.

-Micro Greens almost every week.

-Produce is kept in a controlled environment so it does not wilt or rot while waiting for you take it home.
